3. Students are required to take at least 12 hours per semester, or be classified as a full time student.
4. The scholarship application requires meeting the listed scholarship guidelines, completing content, and grammar. Finalist may be called for personal interview.
5. Family income is not to be a consideration.
6. Students have no restriction on their field of study.
7. Upon proof of enrollment of a place of higher education presented to the office secretary, A check will be issued to the student in their name.
