Scholarships are awarded using the following eligibility requirements:

- 1. Funds shall be used to attend an accredited vocational or technical school, college or university. Student must maintain full time status.
- 2. Applicants must be seniors, graduating within the current school year.
- 3. Currently has no less than a "B" grade average
- 4. Applicant must demonstrate that they have a tentative educational plan and goals, related to fields in agriculture, education, or natural resources (may include Ag Communications, Ag Economics/Business, Ag Education, Wildlife or Ranch Management, etc.).
- 5. Applicants must include the following documents for consideration: (Please send all documents together)
 - a. Completed application
 - b. 1-2 letters of recommendation
 - c. 100-200-word essay on topic given in application
 - d. Local newspaper Information (name, address, phone number)

6. Applications and all supporting documents must be received by April 9, 2021.
