**a. Intro to SHAC**

**i. Changes to meeting requirements/legislation**

A. **HB1525** requires the SHAC meeting be posted 72 hour in advance - audio or video recording of meeting & minutes posted online. School boards must adopt a formal policy establishing a process for adoption of sex ed curriculum material.

B. **Senate Bill 9** - requires public schools to provide instruction relating to the prevention of dating violence, child abuse, and family violence.

**2. Eight Components of the SHAC**

**A. Health Instruction-** Coach Beelitz reports that they have new Health textbooks. She is currently going through the curriculum to see what all topics are addressed. CPR training will be done the second semester for 8th graders and any Seniors who have not had it.

**B. Safe/Healthy School Environment-** Mr. McCasland reports the district has practiced drills and has more scheduled. After the drills, the admin team meets to discuss how the drill went. The district has implemented a new safety app called School Guard. All OISD employees wear a neon badge with their picture ID, so anyone who comes on campus will know they belong. All visitors must check in with the office and have their ID checked before entering a campus. They will be given an ID sticker to wear or a lanyard, so employees know they have been screened in.

**C. Health Services-** Mrs. Workman reports only 8 more students need vaccinations and if they do not have them Monday they will not be allowed on campus. Parents have been notified and are aware. Next year the Health Clinic will be at registration to take care of shots at that time. There will be no grace period next year for not having the appropriate vaccinations. K-5 vision and hearing screenings are being completed. Scoliosis screenings will begin after Thanksgiving. Mrs. Workman has received vouchers for students who may be needing glasses.

**D. Physical Education-** Coach Mandrell reports that the Fitnessgram will begin in November.

**E. School Counseling-** Mrs. Lassiter reports that Red Ribbon Week will be Oct. 24-28. We have dress up days, activities, and speakers planned for the different campuses. There will be an assembly for 8th-12th and one for 5th-7th over the dangers of vaping. There will also be a speaker at the high school discussing the dangers of fentanyl. Counselors have access to CATR and the Lamb/Castro/Swisher Counseling Initiative to refer students for further counseling services. The counselors are very grateful for the extra resources that are available for their students.

**F. Food Service-** Mrs. Workman reports that all students receive free breakfast and lunch. There is a share table in the cafeteria where unopened items go. Mrs. Lassiter has a cart with leftover breakfast items that the students may get at the end of the day if they want a snack. At the high school, they have a room with a refrigerator where students can stop by to get a snack during the day.

**G. School Site Health Promotion-**Kori Workman has reported very few covid cases. If a student tests positive, we follow the 5 day policy. Students may return after that if they have been fever/symptom free. Siblings do not have to quarantine. They will just need to be monitored carefully. There are covid tests in the nurse's office. Mrs. Workman is publishing a monthly newsletter about health and wellness. The flu shot clinic and NHS blood drive were successful.

**H. Involvement with parents/community** Mrs. Workman reported our ABC group has been involved with the volleyball concession stands, book fair, SnackPak4Kids, Hometown Christmas, Breakfast with Santa, OYB, FFA, Play Day
